Sexual Misconduct

An Overview of Sexual Misconduct in Our Community (By Joseph Anibueze, Forensic Psychologist)

Basically, my goal here is at least two folds; encourage anyone that has been sexually abused or molested to go for treatment and come out and report the incident.
